Chair Vickie Gideon opened the meeting at 9:33 a.m.

- 1. Welcome and Introductions: Vickie Gideon called the meeting to order and quorum was met.
- 2. Public Comments: No comments were made by the public.
- **3. Staff Update:** Ms. Owens stated that CTCOG staff had no current updates.
- 4. Action Item: Approve minutes from the May 20, 2020 CTRTAG meeting.

Ebony Jackson made a motion to approve the May 20, 2020 meeting minutes; seconded by Thomas Wilson, the motion passed unanimously.

5. Discussion Item: TxDOT's Public Transportation Division (PTN) Director's report to the Public

Transportation Advisory Committee regarding public transportation matters.

Ms. Owens announced the takeaways from the Texas A&M Transportation Institute (TTI) presentation on

the ridership aspect of the Rural Transit Program. Rural ridership has been decreasing since 2014, but there is not one thing causing the decrease. The largest number of trips fall into four programs: Medical

Transportation, General Public, 5310, and JARC funding.

Terry Reeves discussed the SMP revisions and its effects on HCTD. Supplemental information was

included in the packet.

6. Discussion Item: Reduction in Transit due to COVID-19.

Ms. Owens summarized a report from The State Smart Transportation Initiative, on decreased ridership,

due to COVID-19 and the major financial woes transit cities in the U.S. are facing.

7. Discussion Item: Update from the Hill Country Transit District.

Darrell Burtner provided the committee with an update regarding the Hill Country Transit District's

quarterly reports; and included COVID-19 ridership reports.

8. Discussion Item: COVID-19 Funding Opportunities Regarding Public Transportation.

Ms. Owens gave an overview of the CARES ACT Funding and supplemental information was included.

9. Discussion Item: Discussion of any new unmet transportation needs, gaps and inefficiencies for special

populations and strategies for implementing the FY17-21 RCTP.

Ms. Owens asked that members email new updates from the region.

10. Discussion Item: Board updates.

George Losoya asked if funding from 5310 would be available to help vendors access equipment for special needs populations. Aly McMilian asked that members explore avenues to help the most affected

special needs populations.
