



Hill Country Transit District (the HOP) is a regional public transit system that offers bus service to residents of Temple and surrounding communities. Every bus is wheelchair accessible, and door-to-door paratransit service is available to those that qualify.

Currently two routes operate in Temple each weekday from 5:55am—6:30 pm.

**Service is not available during holidays or weekends.*

From Temple, passengers can connect to routes that will take them to Belton, Harker Heights, Killeen, and Copperas Cove.

The standard fare to ride each route is \$1.00.

**Reduced rates are available for students, Medicare recipients, individuals with disabilities, and those aged 60 or older.*
