Chair Carole Warlick opened the meeting at 1:30 p.m.

- 1. Welcome and Introductions: Chair Carole Warlick called the meeting to order and introductions were made.
- 2. Public Comments: No comments were made by the public.

- 3. Staff Update: John Weber prodived an update on KTMPO meetings and air quality through the end of January 2018. Mr. Weber stated that the CTCOG counties were recommended by EPA as being "attainment/unclassificable."
- **4. Action Item:** Approve minutes from the November 14, 2017 CTRTAG meeting. Vickie Gideon stated that her name was not included in the meeting attendance.

Robert Ator made a motion to approve November 14, 2017 CTRTAG meeting minutes with revisions, seconded by Janell Frazier; the motion passed unanimously.

- 5. Action Item: Regarding approval of new voting member and organizations represented.

  Vice Chair Vickie Gideon made a motion to approve Nancie Etzel as the individual stakesholders representative for the CTRTAG, seconded by Terry Mustapher; the motion passed unanimously.
- 6. Discussion Item: Regarding Regionally Coordinated Transportation Plan (RCTP)
  - a. Status of Continuation Funding;
  - b. PERFORM Regional Planning Workshop;
  - c. Metrics reporting requirement.

Regarding the funding status, Kendra Coufal explained that CTCOG will receive approximately \$25,000 for the first year of the five year update. For years 2-5, funding is based on different.

Kendra Coufal provided an update on the PERFORM Regional Planning Workshop. Ms. Coufal stated that CTRTAG members and staff attended the workshop to discuss best practices to resolve unmet transportation needs identified in regional transportation plans, receive training on collecting and reporting new metrics data, and participate in various discussion sessions.

Ms. Coufal explained that CTCOG has to report regional planning metrics for the period of March 2017 to March 31, 2018. These metrics include collaboration, identification of unmet needs, gaps and inefficiencies, and resolution of unmet needs, gaps and inefficiencies for priority populations. Priority populations are individuals 65 and older, individuals with disabilities, individuals with low incomes, people seeking employment, children, and veterans.

CTRTAG members were given the opportunity to provide their feedback on each metric requirement. Ms. Coufal stated that this item will be discussed again at a future meeting.

Vice Chair Vickie Gideon presided over the rest of the meeting.

7. Discussion Item: Regarding Fact Sheets for Public Transit.

Kendra Coufal presented CTRTAG members with the draft fact sheets for public transit. CTRTAG members provided feedback on the fact sheets and a revised fact sheet will be presented to CTRTAG members at a future meeting.

8. Discussion Item: Regarding Transit Survey for KTMPO Regional Multimodal Plan Update.

Kendra Coufal stated a survey was included in meeting packet for the KTMPO Regional Multimodal Plan. Ms. Coufal asked CTRTAG members to fill out the survey and return it to KTMPO.
