**Grant Preparation Checklist** 

Over \$32 billion is available to the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) in FY 2023 Budget Authority to provide competitive grant funding to local governments, MPOs, transit agencies, and State departments transportation. USDOT has created a checklist for applicants for future funding programs to help them prepare and take advantage of available funding. The checklist provides steps on how to:

- Coordinate Between Agencies and Stakeholders
- Get Familiar with the DOT Calendar of Fundina Opportunities
- Budget For and Secure Your Non-Federal Match
- · Ensure Your Project is on the TIP/STIP
- Get Ready to Apply For and to Administer Federal Funding
- Know your Justice 40 designated Census Tracts
- Prepare Your Capital Project's Benefit Cost Analysis (BCA).
- Budget for Meaningful Public Involvement
- Build a Strong Workforce Development and Labor Plan
- · Understand NEPA and Other Federal Requirements as you Consider Whether to Seek Funding

## Local Fiscal Recovery Funds Flexibility

The FY 2023 omnibus appropriations bill that became law on Dec.29, 2022, included a special provision that would grant cities, counties, and regions greater flexibility when using their remaining State and Local Fiscal Relief Funds (SLFRF). This flex would allow local governments to use SLFRF funds for more uses, including transportation infrastructure. For more information, click here!
